

NAMI NORTHERN LAKES REGULAR MEETING

October, 14, 2014

President Mick Fiocchi called the meeting to order at 6:18 p.m.

Those in attendance were Mick Fiocchi, Pam Morton, Lon Voils, Bob Mangles, Jeanne Pederson, Dan Rondello, and Mary Wright.

Voils made a motion to accept the minutes. Pederson seconded and it was approved with the correction of Mike "Steffens" changed to "Steffes".

Wright stated that we got a \$10,000 contribution to NAMI NORTHERN LAKES from St. Mathias Thrift Shop in Minocqua.

Voils passed out information about a proposal for a peer-run recovery organization program grant application. The Wisconsin Department of Health Services gives out 12 contracts for \$25,000 each that meet federal and state requirements. The due date for the applications is Oct. 31 at 4 p.m. CDT.

Wright made a motion to proceed with the application for peer run recovery organizations. Seconded by Mangles. Motion was approved.

Jim Skubal arrived at 7:14 p.m.

Fiocchi indicated that we have board insurance, liability, and our 501(c)3 status.

Voils indicated that we would be signing papers with Bethesda for the drop-in center on Friday Oct. 17th.

Mangles gave the treasury report. We had \$2,115 in savings and \$876 in checking.

Fiocchi stated that Kristen De Bruyne will be the speaker for the October meeting.
