

NAMI Regular Meeting- March 8, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m. by President Mick Fiocchi. Those in attendance were Mick Fiocchi, Dan Rondello, Audrey Kissinger, Bob Mangles, Sue Janik and Pam Morton. Absent were: Jim Skubal, Mary Wright, and Jeanne Pederson.

Mangles made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Kissinger, and the motion was approved.

Fiocchi indicated that he sent documents and budgets out to the potential new board members.

Fiocchi stated the annual report for NAMI Wisconsin is complete, and the financial review is not required for this year.

Rhinehaus has requested a consumer to come and speak.

We also had a request from PEO for a public presentation.

checking; \$9,611.42 in the Northern Lakes Drop-in Center
Fund, and \$13,967.66 in savings.

Kissinger suggested Kevin Stamper for a speaker for April.
In March we will have our annual meeting. And May is
mental health awareness month.

Dr. Immler was also mentioned as a speaker.
